As the only adult hospice for the people of mid Essex our care extends beyond the inpatient unit and three day hospices to the team of specialist community nurses, social workers, physiotherapists and other healthcare professionals providing expert advice and support to people in their own homes.

By supporting Farleigh Hospice in this way you will also be contributing to recycling in mid Essex by encouraging the re-use of furniture and domestic appliances which would otherwise have gone into landfill sites.

Your questions answered

What do Farleigh Hospice collect?

Collections of clean domestic furniture, small electrical items and bric-a-brac can be arranged by telephone and there is no charge for this service.

Upholstered furniture must comply with fire safety regulations and be in good clean condition and small electrical items must be in working order.


We do not take beds, gas heaters or white goods such as fridges and washing machines. For a full up to date list of what we do and do not collect please visit our website or contact us by phone or email.

How do Farleigh Hospice collect?

We will arrange a day with you for our van and crew to visit. We aim to collect at convenient times up to 6 days a week but are unable to give precise times for collections.

We are always grateful when donors deliver to us direct by prior arrangement as this helps to minimise our costs.

Where do Farleigh Hospice sell donated items?

We sell the majority of goods through our shops (see over) but if we are given surplus, unusual or antique goods we may sell them via auction or on  to raise funds for the Hospice.

For anyone wanting items bought from our shops delivered, there is a one off charge regardless of the number of items purchased.
