<p>Green Box: Glass, metal and textiles</p>  	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Glass bottles and Jars of all colours- please rinse and remove lids</li> <li>✓ Cans- Aerosol cans, food and drink cans, please rinse and crush if possible</li> <li>✓ Aluminium foil and containers- please clean and bag separately</li> <li>✓ Clean textiles- Clothes, sheets, blankets, rags, shoes (tied together) Please bag separately</li> </ul> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>× Broken Glass</li> <li>× Visionware/pirex</li> <li>× Window panes</li> <li>× Paper backed foil or crisp packets</li> <li>× Metal utensils</li> </ul>
