

Access Mission Statement

The access mission for Chelmsford Museum is to provide a high quality, evolving museum service which welcomes all sections of the community regardless of ethnicity, disability, age, gender or sexual orientation. Where possible, the Museum will actively encourage and facilitate visits from people from sections of the community which are currently underrepresented among its visitors. This includes catering for as wide a range of physical and neuro-diverse access needs as possible within resource constraints. There will be broad provision to widen access such as using clear typefaces on display labels. Efforts will also be made to meet some specific needs. For example, pre-visit resources for visitors with autism.

Further, Chelmsford City Council's Access Policy Statement confirms its commitment to accessibility: Our commitment is long term and of continuous improvement as our resources permit. Our aim is to achieve the optimum level of access to the Council's services for all, and to enable the widest possible independent use of the Council's facilities by all sections of our community.
