The museum is fully accessible. Please ask a Visitor Host on the Welcome Desk if you have any questions or need any assistance.

Sensory Rainbow Trail bag, ear defenders, twiddle muff – ask at the front desk if you would like these while you are in the museum.

'I spy picture trails - pick up a sheet, clip board and pencil from the green box by the front desk.

Orange 'hands-on' activity stations – look out for the 'orange based exhibits' in the galleries which have things to touch and do.

This can be noisy and busy at lunchtime, 12.30 – 1.30pm. Entrance from museum. Entrance from the park

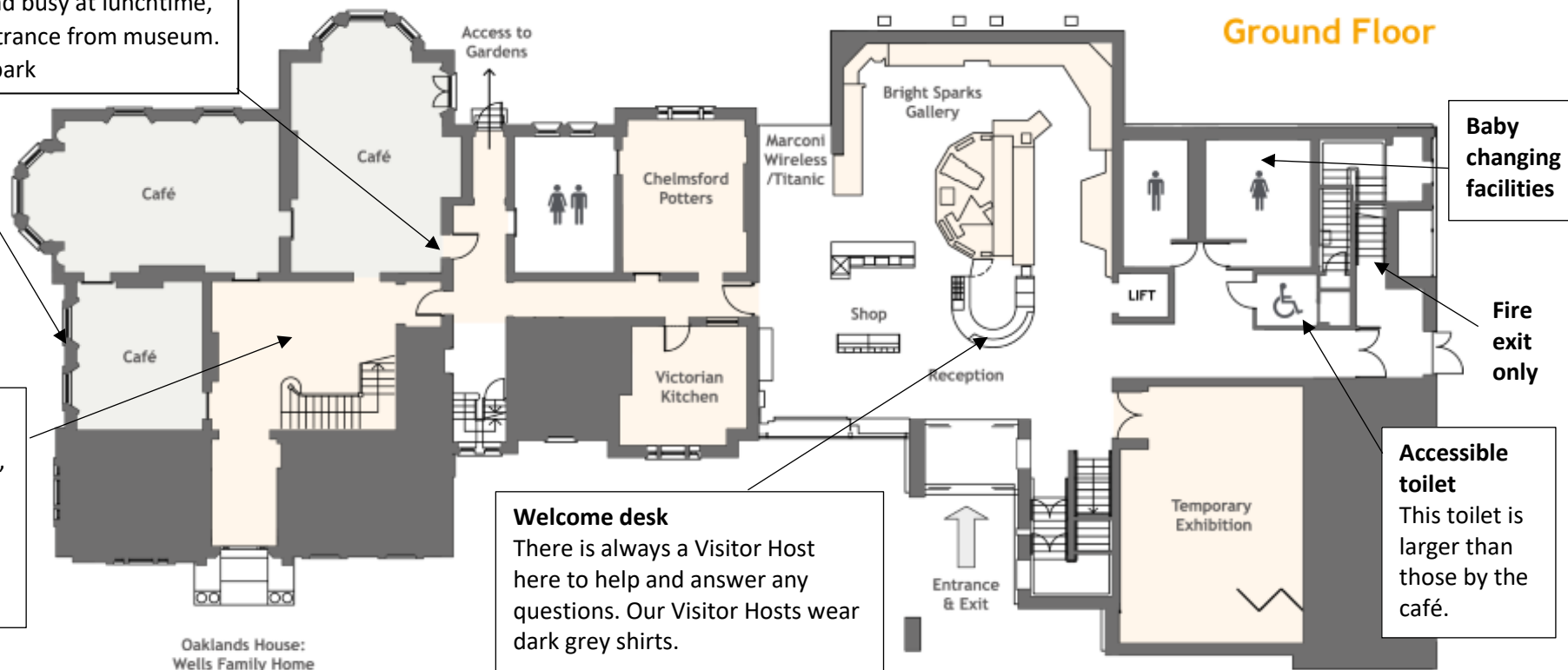
Grand Hall
