(A) Travelling by car

There are two car parks available at Beaulieu Park station:

Car Park A

(Managed by Chelmsford City Council)

This car park has approximately 300 spaces, including:

- 38 Blue Badge bays
- 4 EV charge points
- 75 motorbike spaces

Parking charges and payment methods can be found at **chelmsford.gov.uk/beaulieuparking**

Blue Badge parking is free.

Car Park B

(Operated by NCP on behalf of Greater Anglia)

Around 400 additional spaces (including 6 EV charge points) can be found in Car Park B, approximately 370m walk to the station building.

Taxi ranks & pick up points

There is a free drop off and pick up point immediately outside the station building. The time limit for waiting is 10 minutes, with no return within 20 minutes.

The taxi rank is located just outside the station building.

(Travelling by bus

The canopy-covered bus interchange is next to the main station building. A paved pathway gives level access to the interchange, which has bus bays with raised kerbs.

Several First Bus services will serve Beaulieu Park station:

- C8 between Beaulieu Park and Springfield.
- C9 between Beaulieu Park and Chelmsford city centre.
- C11 between Beaulieu Park station, North Springfield and Chelmsford city centre.
- 73, 73A and 73B between Maldon and Chelmsford.

(36) Travelling by bike

A network of cycle paths has been installed around **Beaulieu Park station**.

There are two cycle storage areas available: one near Car Park A and the other near the bus interchange on the other side of the station.

Secure cycle lockers

There are 500 secure covered lockers providing a dry, safe and locked location to store your bike. These are exclusively for registered bike locker permit holders for a small annual fee.

Free cycle stands

There will also be plenty of free two-tier spaces available, including accessible spaces. Instructions on how to use these will be displayed at the site.

Customer services in the station building

There's step-free access to the station concourse where you'll find everything you need for your journey:

- Customer service staff on site from the first to the last train.
- Eight electronic ticket machines and free Wi-Fi.
- Three platforms, with platforms 1 and 2 accessible via a stair bridge or lift.
- Seated waiting areas by platform 3, and a waiting room on platforms 1 and 2.
- Tactile wayfinding and braille throughout.

(ກໍ່ໄດ້) Toilet facilities

Toilets, including accessible toilets and baby changing facilities, are located beyond the gateline by platforms 2 and 3. A Changing Places toilet is also available for radar key holders adjacent to platform 3.
