1. Apologies for Absence

Apologies for absence were received from Councillor N Walsh and Parish Councillor P Jackson.

2. Appointment of Vice Chair

RESOLVED that Councillor N Dudley be appointed as Vice Chair of the Committee for 2022/23.

3. Minutes

The minutes of the meeting on 9 March 2022 were confirmed as a correct record.

4. Declarations of Interest

All Members were reminded to declare any Disclosable Pecuniary interests or other registerable interests where appropriate in any items of business on the meeting's agenda. None were made.

5. Chair's Announcements

The Chair had no announcements to make.

6. Monitoring Officer Report

The Committee received a report from the Monitoring Officer on the latest statistical data for complaints under the standards regime. It showed that four complaints had been received between November 2021 and February 2022, with a total of 16 currently under investigation.

The Monitoring Officer said that dates for hearings to consider two of the outstanding complaints would be circulated to members.

Members were informed that a large proportion of complaints related to the failure of parish councillors to complete or provide up to date registration of interest forms. The Monitoring Officer proposed to report annually to the Committee on compliance with that requirement by both City Council and parish council levels.

In response to comments and questions from members about the registration of parish councillors' interests, the Monitoring Officer acknowledged that the members of some parish councils had not completed interests forms despite repeated reminders to do so. The Parish Clerks would continue to be encouraged to ensure that the members of their councils completed and kept up to date their registration of interests and, as part of the new Code of Conduct, would be issued with guidance on how best to do that and advice on dealing with those members who failed to register their interests. Consideration would also be given to introducing after the next scheduled elections an electronic-based system for the registration of members' interests.

RESOLVED that

- 1. the statistical information on complaints and the action taken in response to them be noted and published on the Council's website; and
- 2. the addition of an annual report to the committee workplan relating to the updating of the register of interests at both city and parish level be noted.

7. Gifts and Hospitality

The Monitoring Officer submitted a report which showed that no offers of gifts and hospitality had been made to councillors and officers in 2021.

RESOLVED that the information on the offer of gifts and hospitality in 2021 be noted.

8. Amendments to the Constitution

The Constitution Working Group on 25 May 2022 had recommended to the Committee, Cabinet and Council proposed amendments to the Constitution relating to meetings rules and revised Financial Rules. Separately, the Mayoral Working Group on 31 May had reviewed the Mayoral Party Rules and Protocol and had suggested a number of changes.

The Committee's consideration of the Working Group's recommendations focused on the following issues:

- whether the Chair of the Policy Board should be consulted on what constituted a
 minor change to policy in the exercise of the proposed delegation 3.4.1.3.
 The Committee was informed that not all policies to which the delegation would apply
 would fall within the purview of the Policy Board. However, under the proposed
 delegation there would be a discussion between officers and the appropriate
 members before it was exercised; and
- whether the proposal to limit the ability of smaller opposition groups to speak at Cabinet would disenfranchise those groups. It was suggested by a member of the smaller opposition group on the Committee that it might be more reasonable to limit that restriction to groups of fewer than five members.
 The Committee was told that the Constitution was reviewed at about this time annually and that therefore any changes to group sizes after scheduled elections, and whether it was necessary to review their input to Cabinet meetings, could be addressed fairly quickly. The opposition group member who made the earlier suggestion noted that but maintained his objection to the proposal as currently worded.

RESOLVED that, subject to any comments the Cabinet might have, the Council be recommended to approve the following changes to the Constitution:

1. Part 3.2.4 – Advisory Panels

Community Funding Panel - Amend the membership by replacing the Cabinet Member for Sustainable Development with the Cabinet Member for Greener and Safer Chelmsford

Chelmer Waterside Project Panel - Add the Director of Public Places to the membership of the Panel

2. Part 3.4 – Officer Delegations

(a) Part 3.4.1 - Delegations to all Directors - Add new delegation 3.4.1.3 and renumber subsequent delegations:

"In consultation with the relevant Cabinet Member or Chair, to make minor changes to existing policies and strategies."

(b) Delegation 3.4.7.5 to the Director of Sustainable Communities - Amend existing delegation to read:

"Preparation, consultation and monitoring of planning policies and proposals within statutory development plans, supplementary planning documents and planning guidance."

(c) New delegation to the Director of Sustainable Communities - Add new sub-heading:

"Specific delegations"

and new delegation 3.4.7.25

"Responses to consultations on Nationally Significant Infrastructure proposals as defined by section 14 of the Planning Act 2008 and other proposals of statutory bodies and agencies, and proposed changes to national planning policy and guidance."

3. Part 4.4 - Executive Rules

(a) Rule 4.4.5.6 (a) – Amend to read:

"the largest minority political group- shall, at the Annual Meeting of the Full Council, nominate spokespersons to speak or ask questions on specific Cabinet functions. The spokespersons may nominate deputies to speak in their absence. In addition, the largest opposition group may nominate spokespersons for the areas of responsibility of Cabinet Deputies;"

- (b) Rule 4.4.5.6(b) No change
- (c) Rule 4.4.5.6(c) Amend to read:

"with the exception of the ability to nominate deputies, the arrangements described in (b) above shall apply to any political groups other than the largest minority group and to councillors who do not constitute or belong to political groups, but they shall each be limited to contributing no more than twice at a meeting by way of asking questions or speaking on an item;"

9. Model Code of Conduct

The Constitution Working Group on 25 May 2022 had recommended that the Council adopt the latest version of the Local Government Association's Model Code of Conduct for Councillors.

The Committee discussed whether offers of gifts and hospitality that were refused or not responded to should be declared and what, in practical terms, actually constituted a gift or an offer of hospitality. The Monitoring Officer advised that, for the purposes of openness, it was best to declare all such offers. However, there may be occasions, such as invitations to attend Council or Mayoral functions at which hospitality was provided, when it would not be necessary to declare them because they formed part of a councillor's day-to-day Council-related activities. Thought would be given to drawing up guidance on gifts and hospitality to cover this and other areas that may need clarifying.

RESOLVED that the Council be recommended to adopt the latest version of the Local Government Association's Model Code of Conduct for Councillors.

Standards Complaints 24 – 27/21 Investigation and Hearing Report

Purpose

To undertake a hearing in relation to the four complaints (relating to three issues/activities) concerning a City Councillor - Cllr Wendy Daden.

Recommendations

1. To consider and determine whether there have been breaches of the code of conduct by Cllr Wendy Daden and if so what, if any, action should be taken.

1. Background

- 1.1 Four formal complaints were received by the Monitoring Officer during October 2021 by four different members of the public alleging various breaches of the code of conduct. In accordance with committee procedures, the complaints were referred for investigation.
- 1.2The investigator has reported back their views concerning the complaints. Members are asked to hear and determine whether there has been any breach of the City Council code of conduct in force at the time of the allegations. If it is determined that there has been any breach of the code of conduct then members are asked to consider whether, and if so, what appropriate action should be taken.
- 1.3 All the allegations relate to different activities by the councillor to promote a drug lvermectin. It should be noted that medical opinion for or against the use of this drug will not be relevant in reaching a decision as to whether there has been any breach of the code of conduct.
- 1.4 It is a matter of public record that the Committee heard different allegations that Cllr Daden had breached the Broomfield Parish Council code of conduct in February 2022. It should be noted that the allegations in relation to this matter pre date that hearing.

2. Alleged breaches to be considered by Committee

- 2.1 The complaints against the councillor are set out within an investigator's report which can be found at Appendix 2. Some minor redaction to the investigator's report has been necessary to remove personal data relating to parties to the complaint. The investigator's report provides details of the complaints together with the background and the conclusions reached in relation to each allegation. Members are asked to make a formal determination in relation to each allegation concerning Cllr Daden.
- 2.2A brief overview of the complaints together with the views of the investigator are as set out in this paragraph.
- 2.3 Complaints ref 24 & 26/21 both relate to a leaflet produced by the councillor which one of the complainants allege was disrespectful (ref 24/21) and the other that this was an improper use of the Councillor's position for personal advantage/breach of Nolan principles (26/21). The investigators views are that

these allegations are finely balanced but considers the Councillor was acting in private capacity and as such could not have breached the code of conduct.

- 2.4 Complaint ref 25/21 relates to facebook posts by the councillor which are alleged to breach nolan principles. The investigator concludes that the councillor was acting in private capacity and that no breach of the code of conduct can therefore arise.
- 2.5 Complaint ref 27/21 relates to the councillors ward newsletter which was alleged to bring the council into disrepute. The investigator concludes that the councillor was acting in official capacity and could have breached the code of conduct.

3. Relevant procedures

- 3.1 The determination of complaints alleging breaches of the code of conduct by members is governed by the Complaints Procedure at Part 5.1.2 of the Constitution. This provides that the Monitoring Officer will review every complaint received and will consult an Independent Person before taking a decision to investigate a complaint.
- 3.2The Committee should conduct a hearing to receive the report of the Investigating Officer and to hear the representations of the Councillor against whom the allegations are made. Before reaching decisions on the complaints the advice of an Independent Person must be sought.
- 3.3 If the Committee decides that there has been a breach of the code of conduct it must consider what, if any, action to take. Before reaching a decision the advice of an Independent Person must be sought.

 - Whether any recommendations should be made to the Council, or where appropriate the Parish or Town Council, with a view to promoting high standards of conduct amongst Councillors.
- 6.4 The Committee will leave the room to consider these representations and to decide what if any action should be taken, in consultation with the Independent Person, if present, and may request the Monitoring Officer or other legal advisor to the Committee to accompany them.
- 6.5 On the Committee's return the Chair will announce the Committee's decision.
- 6.6 The Chair will confirm that a full written decision shall be issued within 10 working days following the hearing and that the Committee's findings will be published as

INVESTIGATION REPORT Complaints 24/21 – 27/21

Investigator – Jenny Koon Koon

Investigation Report Complaints 24/21 – 27/21

1. I Jenny Koon Koon am a Solicitor employed by Hertfordshire County Council. I have investigated four complaints that have been brought by members of the public against Councillor Wendy Daden (Cllr Daden).

Methodology

- 2. Before starting the investigation, Lorraine Browne, Monitoring Officer for Chelmsford City Council provided Cllr Daden with copies of the complaints and supporting documents that I have considered.
- 3. As well as the documentation provided by the complainants, I have also considered a copy of Cllr Daden's business card which has been provided to me as background information. I have also taken steps to review the website www.wendydaden.co.uk which was identified as part of the communications from Cllr Daden.
- 4. Finally, as background information I have been provided with the following email communications:
 - a) an email from a member of the public to Cllr Daden, raising concerns about her leaflet communication.
 - b) Emails between Lorraine Browne and Cllr Daden regarding advice on Cllr Daden's website.
 - c) Email communication from a Chelmsford resident supporting Cllr Daden's communications.
- 5. All background information can be found in Appendix 1 of this report.
- 6. I have focussed my investigation on the following two questions:
 - a) In relation to each individual complaint, was Cllr Daden acting in her capacity as a member of Chelmsford City Council so as to engage the Code of Conduct?
 - b) If so, have her actions potentially breached the Councillors Code of Conduct?

Application of the Code of Conduct

- 7. A full copy of the Councillors Code of Conduct can be found at Appendix 2.
- 8. 5.1.1.1 of the Code of Conduct states that the code applies when someone is acting in their capacity as a member or co-opted member, which is referred to in the Code as "Councillor" of Chelmsford City Council including:
 - At formal meetings of the Council, its Committees and Sub-Committees, its Cabinet and other meetings at which business of the Council is discussed (5.1.1.1.2)
 - When acting as a representative of the Council (5.1.1.1.2)
 - In taking any decision as a Cabinet member or as a Ward Councillor (5.1.1.1.4)
 - In discharging your functions as a Ward Councillor (5.1.1.1.5)
 - At briefing meetings with officers (5.1.1.1.6)
 - At site visits or other visits to do with the business of the Council (5.1.1.1.7)
 - When corresponding with the Council other than in a private capacity (5.1.1.1.8)
- 9. Of the above, in relation to the current complaints' consideration needs to be given as to whether Cllr Daden was, as part of her communications, either acting as a representative of the Council (5.1.1.1.2) or discharging her functions as a Ward Councillor (5.1.1.1.5).
- 10. The Local Government Association (LGA) describes the role of a Councillor as:

A councillor's primary role is to represent their ward or division and the people who live in it. Councillors provide a bridge between the community and the council. As well as being an advocate for local residents and signposting them to the right people at the council, you will need to keep them informed about the issues that affect them.

In order to understand and represent local views and priorities, you need to build strong relationships and encourage local people to make their views known and engage with you and the council. Good communication and engagement are central to being an effective councillor.

As a local councillor, your residents will expect you to:

- respond to their queries and investigate their concerns (casework)
- communicate council decisions that affect them
- know your patch and be aware of any problems
- know and work with representatives of local organisations, interest groups and businesses
- represent their views at council meetings
- lead local campaigns on their behalf.

CIIr Daden's Response

- 11. Whilst I did seek to meet with Cllr Daden via MS Teams to ask questions in relation to the complaints, Cllr Daden politely declined. I therefore offered Cllr Daden the opportunity for me to put written questions to her for response. Cllr Daden agreed and written questions were provided to her on 17 March 2022. Cllr Daden provided a response on 22 March 2022. A copy of my questions and Cllr Daden's response can be found at Appendix 7.
- 12. I have considered this response in full and highlight the following which appears to me relevant to the investigation:
 - (a) Cllr Daden has confirmed that the logo which is presented on both the leaflet and newsletters was '...designed to represent all people what ever party you support whatever your view'.
 - (b) Cllr Daden has confirmed that she considers all her communications and actions to be her acting in a personal capacity.
 - (c) That Cllr Daden feels that she has not received clear guidance as to how she as an Independent can assert her right to free speech and expressions without being harassed for it.

The Complaints

Complaint 24/21 and 26/21

- 13. As complaints 24/21 and 26/21 relate to the same leaflet, I have considered these complaints together.
- 14. Complaint 24/21 states:

'I have received anti vax leaflet through my door in name of Wendy Daden. My husband duly let the people know to take back their litter with them. As NHS staff I find it trully offensive and abhorrent behaviour by person in public office. This is shameful and disrespectful to all the people who lost their lives to covid19 or are still effected by it. This should be subject to disciplinary proceedings. If I receive such communication again I will report it to the police'

15. For the avoidance of doubt, no documentation was provided by the Complainant.

16. Complaint 26/21 states:

'I received a leaflet through my door on 11/10/21 (please see attached file) which has been created and distributed by councillor Wendy Daden. Although it states "not representing anyone but me" at the bottom of the leaflet, I would argue that Clir Daden is still trying to validate her anti-Covid vaccination misinformation by putting her name and a logo at the top of the leaflet in a style which most people would associate with politics. She is aware that many people in the community will recognise her name and that she is a local councillor, and is therefore trying to take advantage of this position of authority and trust to influence the thoughts and actions of others. To emphasise my point, if I (as someone not well known in my community) were to create a leaflet. I would not put my name in large, bold letters next to a logo at the top of the leaflet as this would serve absolutely no purpose. In addition, the leaflet also advises readers to visit Cllr Daden's personal website, within which it is repeatedly stated that she is a local councillor. With regard to specific breaches of the code of conduct: - 5.1.1.2.1.7 - for the reasons stated above, Cllr Daden is using her position as a councillor for personal advantage and certainly not in the public interest. The leaflet claims that vaccines offer "zero safety." It is a leaflet about Covid vaccinations and contains references to Thalidomide, asbestos and cigarettes under the title "do you trust their science?" This is obviously not in the public interest as it is an attempt to scare members of my community into dismissing the advice given by public health experts and doctors - 5.1.1.2.1.11 - in her decision and action to create this leaflet, the principle of objectivity has not been applied. Almost the entire leaflet is subjective and therefore dangerous as it is trying to influence the reader's decisions regarding their health. "The worst medical advice ever is to do nothing for 14 days". "If you take it (Ivermectin), you will not get sick". These are just two examples of factually incorrect statements which completely lack objectivity.'

17. The documentation provided by the Complainant can be found at Appendix 3.

Consideration

18. The leaflet referred to in both complaints uses the following logo:



- 19. Such logo has also been used on Cllr Daden's Business Card which clear identifies her as 'local INDEPENDENT for Broomfield and Writtle'.
- 20. As part of my investigation, I asked Cllr Daden the following four questions in relation to this logo:
- a) What in your view does this logo stand for/represent?
- b) Is this logo linked to your role as Parish and/or City Councillor?
- c) If not, please confirm whether you use this logo on day to day correspondence outside your role as a Parish and/or City Councillor?
- d) Where possible please provide examples of when you would use this logo in your private capacity?
- 21. Cllr Daden has responded to question 1, stating that the logo was '...designed to represent all people what ever party you support whatever your view'.
- 22. A clear response to questions 2 -4 was not provided although a blanket response regarding capacity was provided stating 'I therefore consider all my communications and actions as me acting in a personal capacity.'
- 23.In Complaint 26/21 the Complainant refers to the end of the leaflet and the mention of Cllr Daden's website which repeatedly refers to her as a Councillor. The bottom of the leaflet states:
 - 'NOT REPRESENTING ANYONE BUT ME: For evidence and more information please visit www.wendydaden.co.uk or call me for a chat 0771 555 3 222'
- 24. As part of my investigation I have reviewed this website and screenshots of relevant parts can be found at Appendix 1. For the avoidance of doubt, these screenshots are a sample of the website which appeared relevant to the question of capacity and does not represent the full website.
- 25. The Website homepage states:

'Hi, I'm Wendy Daden, living in Chelmsford – welcome to my website, which does not represent any organisation I am a mum from Broomfield, currently serving as an Independent Councillor for Broom field Parish and Chelmsford City Council.

26. The website then has the following tabs:

Covid-19 – Providing information and links regarding Covid-19

News - Providing Local News and Covid News

My Issues – Providing articles on Overdevelopment, Road Safety, Council Tax and Broomfield Hospital to name a few

Profile – Which provides information about Cllr Daden, her politics, her Chelmsford City Council Campaign

Complaints – Providing information about a Complaint made against Cllr Daden as Broomfield Parish Councillor.

27. The following question was raised with Cllr Daden as part of the investigation:

'The Complainant goes on to raise concern that the leaflet provides a link for your website www.wendydaden.co.uk which states you are a local councillor. I have reviewed your website and note it does refer to you as a Parish and City Councillor and provides information under the profile tab headings 'My Politics' and 'My Chelmsford Council Campaign'.

- 1) Does this website, in part or in full, relate to your position as a Parish and City Councillor?
- 2) If no, do you have any other form of website that provides information about you in your capacity as Parish Councillor and/or City Councillor? If so, please provide details of the same.'
- 28. No response was forthcoming other than the blanket response that all communications and actions have been in a personal capacity:

Decision

- 29.I have found this issue to be finely balanced. The style of the leaflet, with prominent positioning of Cllr Daden's full name and logo, which is also used in relation to her role as parish councillor, is highly likely to give the impression to those who know Cllr Daden as either a Parish or City Councillor that such leaflet has links to these roles. However, nowhere on the leaflet does Cllr Daden refer to her role as either Parish or City Councillor or that the views expressed within the leaflet are representative of either Broomfield Parish Council or Chelmsford City Council. Instead, it has been clearly marked that the leaflet is '...not representing anyone but me'.
- 30. As set out above, the leaflet provides an address for Cllr Daden's website. This advises that the website does not represent any organisation but does then go on to advise of Cllr Daden's status as both a Parish Councillor and City Councillor. The website provides information about Covid-19 and also about Cllr Daden's politics, but again, at no time does the information about Covid-19 (which the leaflet relates to) conjoin with the information about Cllr Daden's work as a Councillor and no reference is made to any information being provided as a representative of Chelmsford City Council.

- 31.I therefore return to the Code of Conduct and in particular the question as to whether Cllr Daden was, as part of her communications either acting as a representative of the Council (5.1.1.1.2) or discharging her functions as a Ward Councillor (5.1.1.1.5). I believe, on the balance of probabilities, that Cllr Daden was not acting in her capacity as Councillor when creating and distributing the leaflet provided by the Complainant. This is on the basis that she has purposefully stated in the communication that she is not representing anyone but herself. She does not hold herself out to be a representative of Chelmsford City Council in this leaflet or make any reference to her position as either parish or city Councillor. Whilst the individual impressions of the complainants are that this communication is linked to her role as a Councillor, I do not believe that this engages the Code of Conduct in this matter.
- 32. It is therefore my view that the Code of Conduct has not been engaged in relation to this complaint. In light of this I have not gone on further to consider any alleged breach of the Code of Conduct.

Advice

- 33. I note in her response Cllr Daden feels that further guidance is required as to how she can assert her right to free speech and expression. Whilst I am not able to provide blanket advice on this point, as it is dependent on the circumstances in each instance, in relation to the current concerns raised I believe further steps could be taken by Cllr Daden when communicating in her private capacity to avoid confusion, such as:
 - a) Not using any form of logo in private communications or when writing in her personal capacity
 - b) Not referring to the website www.wendydaden.co.uk when acting in a personal capacity or alternatively taking steps to ensure this website is solely a personal website, not linked in any way to her role as a Councillor.

Complaint 25/21

34. Complaint 25/21 states:

'I would like to make a complaint to the monitoring officer about the conduct of Cllr Wendy Daden. She has been promoting anti vaccine / false news regarding covid 19 and vaccines on Facebook and promoting the Bird Group - a group which is calling for ivermectin to be used to treat covid. I wish to remain anonymous and do not consent to my information being shared with the cllr in question. She is sharing this information in the Broomfield and Walthams community group on Facebook. As a local cllr she has a responsibility not to promote fake news and conspiracy theories regarding covid 19 vaccines. In her posts she intentionally introduces spaces or uses "v" instead of writing vaccine in attempts to avoid Facebook deducting her posts as fake antivax conspiracy. I believe this behaviour is not consistent with the Nolan Committee's principles of selflessness, honesty, integrity, objectivity, accountability, openness and leadership by this councillor.'

35. The Complainant provided screen shots of Facebook posts which can be found at Appendix 4.

Decision

- 36. Having reviewed the Facebook communication, it is my view that Cllr Daden was acting in her personal capacity when responding to comments on the Broomfield and Waltham's Community Group. It is clear in one of the responses she herself confirms that she is speaking in a personal capacity. Just because Cllr Daden holds the role of City and Parish Councillor, does not mean that her comments on Facebook are in her capacity as such and I have seen nothing in this posts that show Cllr Daden to be acting as either a representative of the Council or discharging the functions of a Ward Councillor.
- 37. It is therefore my view that the Code of Conduct has not been engaged in relation to this complaint. In light of this I have not gone on further to consider any alleged breach of the Code of Conduct.

Complaint 27/21

38. Complaint 27/21 states:

'Ms. Daden, an Independent member of the Council regularly sends 'round-robin' email newsletter to constituents which helpfully informs us of council business. local community activities and suchlike. However, in her latest emails she has been actively promoting the use of an unproven drug, Ivermectin, as a treatment for Covid. She has also included links to the so-called 'Pro-Choice' movement. which is a promoter of anti vaccination, and whose supporters in the US and Britain have harassed medical staff, hospitals for not providing Ivermectin on request to patients with covid symptoms. Ms. Daden has also publicly and passionately sought to persuade local residents to engage in a campaign to promote Ivermectin (and by definition follow conspiracy theorists in Pro-Choice and associated largely US groups) by putting up posters, following links to antivaxxers and Ivermectin promoters in the US, and to engage in a campaign to completely unproven (anti-parasitical) drug whose manufacturers disclaim its relevance to covid treatment. By so doing she is encouraging people to take a drug which has no proven track record in treating covid, potentially putting her constituents who follow such links, at risk of harm. By her enthusiastic promotion of the drug, under the guise of 'encouraging critical thought' and 'challenging government medical advice I believe she is encouraging residents to subscribe to harmful conspiracy 'theories'. By so doing she is in breach of General Code of Conduct 5.1.1.2.1.6, 'conducting herself in a manner likely to bring the Council into disrepute'.'

39. Copies of the newsletters referred to and correspondence between Cllr Daden and the Complainant can be seen at Appendix 5.

Consideration

- 40. The Complainant is a constituent of Waltham and Broomfield Parish. As part of the Complaint the Complainant provided copies of two newsletters, one headed 'Wendy Daden Apolicital campaigner for transparent governance' (the First Newsletter) and one headed 'Daden News' (the Second Newsletter).
- 41. The First Newsletter covers the following topics:
 - a) Monsters are arriving in Chelmsford Half terms event
 - b) Chelmsford North East Bypass Planning Application Submission
 - c) City Council News Community Governance Review
 - d) Broomfield Christmas Craft Fair
 - e) Ivermectin
- 42. The bottom of the newsletter states 'All material is personal opinion and is not endorsed by any organisation'.
- 43. The Second Newsletter provides Covid News alone.

- 44. As part of my investigation, I met with the Complainant via MS Team and a copy of my questions and the Complainants responses can be found at Appendix 6.
- 45. As part of my interview I asked the following questions which are relevant to consideration regarding capacity:

Do you consider you signed up to receive information from Wendy Daden as a private citizen or as a Councillor?

Clearly in her capacity as a local councillor/ council representative, feeding back on council proceedings, local interest items and local issues.

How do the content of these emails/newsletters differed from other emails/newsletter you have received from Wendy Daden?

'...regularly meet and talk with others in the community and heard from others that there was similar information on Facebook and other social media that I do not use, and I was aware that other people were concerned about it. I was also aware that she was circulating leaflets which suggested people should lobby their GP.

What triggered my concern was that the 19 September newsletter was normal business content until right at the end with an entry marked 'Groundbreaking'. I presumed that she may have been hacked as tacked on the end was a promotional message for Ivermectin, basically encouraging people to follow up on this – referred to Pro choice, which is understood to link to anti vaccination groups. This raised my concern and I was going to contact her and ask if she had been hacked as this looked odd on the bottom of the normal newsletter. I have done own research into Ivermectin and felt I was talking from a reasonably informed position. That was why I responded the way I did in my email. As can been seen I state that I appreciate her communications but felt this was sensationalist and inappropriate in her capacity as a councillor as she was effectively promoting an unproven and controversial treatment.'

- 46. On reviewing Cllr Daden's website I noted that there is a newsletter subscription page where individuals can provide their names and email addresses in order to receive newsletters (see Appendix 1).
- 47. The First Newsletter is providing information relevant to constituents of the Broomfield Parish as well as constituents of Chelmsford. Whilst there is reference to all material being personal opinion, in fact the content in no way provides personal opinion.
- 48. It is clear from the Complainant's interview that the style of the newsletter was in line with that which is normally received from Cllr Daden, other than the insertion of the information about Ivermectin.

Decision

49. It is my view that through this newsletter Cllr Daden is discharging her functions as a Ward Councillor as she is clearly keeping constituents who have signed up for these newsletters informed of issues that affect them, such as planning application submissions and community governance reviews.

50. It is therefore my view that that the Code of Conduct is engaged. In light of this I have gone on to consider whether there is any potential breach of the Code of Conduct.

Code of Conduct Consideration

- 51. In the complaint the Complainant alleges the following breach:
 - 5.1.1.2.1.6, 'conducting herself in a manner likely to bring the Council into disrepute'.'
- 52. Cllr Daden was asked as part of my written questions to provide her view on this alleged breach. Whilst no direct response was provided, the following appear to me to be relevant for consideration:

'I don't like tribal politics, I have yet to find one tribe that is always right. But generally, whatever party elected members represent, I have found they <u>are</u> working for what they believe is the greater good. I include myself in that and it is all anyone can do. It is only natural some of us think differently and I support their right to do so.

I have been told for literally years; I cannot speak as a councillor without the councils blessing as I may not reflect the council's position. I have always been respectful of that; I have never understood that to mean I cannot have a voice in the world and I ensure my voice upholds the Nolan principles.'

- 53. Returning to the LGA description of a role of a Councillor at page 3 of this report, this focusses on the need to represent the Councillors ward and the people who live in it. To advocate for local residents and communicate Council decisions which affect them.
- 54. In considering the First Newsletter created by Cllr Daden, it is my view that most of the information in this newsletter meets this task. However, it is also my view that Cllr Daden has then gone beyond this role by providing promotional information for Ivermectin with the strap line 'The unsung hero Safe, Low Cost, Beats COVID-19' and providing links to three separate websites.
- 55. In comparison, the Second Newsletter created by Cllr Daden provides no information relating to the Council or Council issues impacting local residents and talks only of Covid-19 and Ivermectin. This newsletter appears to go further than just providing information but actively seeks for recipients to themselves promote Ivermectin, stating:

Can you help spread the word?

- Write to your doctor or MP. Template here
- Fund a banner or leaflets
- Display a banner or leaflets in your window. (Can be provided)
- Help deliver leaflets, to your road
- Share this emailer.

- 56. In interview responses the Complainant referred to three or four other Broomfield residents expressing concern about Cllr Daden's promotion of Ivermectin which they felt was inappropriate as her role as a Councillor. The Complainant also felt the reference to Ivermectin was out of place, so much so that the Complainants first concern was that Cllr Daden had been hacked.
- 57. The Complainant went on to state:

'I am not trying to be vindictive in any way. She is very welcome to her own views on these things and if she holds anti-vaccination views that is up to her. In her email to me she states that she had never been comfortable with politicians meddling in medicine but I felt the newsletters were over the top and promotional which was outside her responsibilities as a Councillor. Have your own ideas, but don't share with your constituents.'

- 58. This view should however be balance against the views of another Chelmsford resident who took time to contact the Council, stating:
 - "... I just wanted to let you know how uplifted I was to see someone actually provide information outside the current robotic narrative and how refreshing it is to see someone helping people become more informed of their choices."

Decision

- 59. Views around Covid, including regarding vaccinations and alternatives treatments are subjects which have proven to be particularly divisive. Whilst Councillors are of course free to hold their own personal opinions in relation to such topics, it is not the role of a Councillor to provide their unsolicited views on such subjects to their constituents, whatever that view may be.
- 60.I believe that the references to COVID-19 and Ivermectin in the newsletter were outside the bounds of the role of a Councillor. Cllr Daden's use of such newsletters to promote her personal views on Covid treatments does have the potential to impact the public's trust in Cllr Daden herself and potentially the wider Council and therefore I believe her actions have potentially brought the Council into disrepute.

Dear Councillor Daden,

Firstly, I note that you have updated your website in light of our discussions and this will be considered in relation to the further standards complaints that I have notified you have since been received. Given the further complaints I do not consider it appropriate at this stage for you to contact the earlier complainant (or the new complainants) even if they were happy with you doing so.

In relation to your queries about the scope of my role in parish matters and personal capacity of councillors. I assist parish councils where possible and in an advisory capacity, particular if this can help avoid ethical issues. It is not for me or the City Council to intervene or direct issues where the parish council has autonomy in determining its position/decisions.

Similarly whilst I cannot advise members on personal or political matters, it is not uncommon for councillors to seek advise to make sure they have understood the position and I will confirm my position as MO. City Councillors from the main political parties and independent councillors (whether in a political group or not) are bound by the same code of conduct and Council rules. However, when a councillor from a political group uses their political party website to promote something it is probably less likely to be construed as them acting as a councillor. An independent group can operate in the same way as a political party but I recognise this is often not the case. Political parties, MPs and councillors from other authorities would have their own codes of conduct and rules although sometimes there are similarities/overlaps with Council requirements.

Finally, in relation to member training I have consulted with the member development group and will be notifying members when this has been arranged. This may not be the appropriate forum to discuss matters which relate to ongoing confidential complaints but we can discuss that further at the appropriate time.

Following our discussion I wanted to confirm that I have been contacted by a resident about promotional material delivered to them from you as the "local Independent for Broomfield and Writtle" for the above. I have previously written to you about the need to ensure any views you wish to promote that are outside of CCC policy are only undertaken in your private capacity. This is clearly an issue outside of Council policy and I would have expected any councillor to exercise real caution and/or take advice from me to ensure their actions cannot be linked to city council. This may well be a concern to Broomfield Parish Council too as I recognise it also may not have authorised you to promote this medicine.

The website (to which residents are referred to on the card/leaflets which have been delivered) clearly explains that you are a city councillor. Your private views are entirely a matter for you but it is not acceptable for you to be promoting these views referencing that you are a city (and parish) councillor in this way.

I note that you agreed to stop delivering any further material which references you as a local independent for Broomfield and Writtle and that the website will also be updated to remove references to the city and/or parish councillor roles. You also agreed to cease leaflet/card deliveries immediately and to update the website, notifying me that this has been completed by 10 am tomorrow.

I shall await hearing from you further.



My greatest concern is the censorship around Nobel prize winning scientists and leading independent vaccine developers that are warning us about ADE, supported by high case numbers in highly vaccinated countries and yet they are not in the MSM. Do you have a view on this?

We need to have an open debate to generate safe science not just be led by those profiting.

I am writing to express my concern and frustration upon receiving an anti-Covid vaccination leaflet through my door from your fellow councillor, Wendy Daden.

Despite the apparent disclaimer at the bottom of the leaflet stating "not representing anyone but me", I'm sure that you're aware that this kind of misinformation is very dangerous, especially as many in the community may recognise the author as being a local councillor (this is also clearly stated on the website that the leaflet advises readers to visit) which could inappropriately give these ideas some validation.

If you have not seen the leaflet I am referring to, the most concerning statements include:

- "natural immunity offers greater protection" (than a vaccine)
- "offering zero safety" (with regard to the safety of Covid vaccinations)
- "do you 'trust their science'"? (below which are references to thalidomide, asbestos and cigarettes)
- "the worst medical advice ever is to do nothing for 14 days" (with regard to taking Ivermectin if you have Covid)
- "if you take it (Ivermectin), you will not get sick"

In my role as a doctor, as in many other professions such as law and the police force, there is an implicit level of public trust in us, therefore we must be very careful how we behave both within and outside of work. Freedom of speech is not a principle which can be blindly applied to any views we may wish to air in the public domain. I would like to think that this is also applicable to yourselves.

I am keen to hear your views on the above, and what action (if any) you will take to ensure that misinformation such as the leaflet in question is not distributed by individuals who are supposed to act responsibly and in the best interest of the communities that they serve.

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5.1.1.1	1.1.1 <u>APPLICATION OF THE CODE</u>		
5.1.1.1.1		This Code of Conduct applies to you whenever you are acting in you capacity as a member or co-opted member ("referred to in this Code as Councillors") of the Chelmsford City Council including-	
5.1.1.1.2		At formal meetings of the Council, its Committees and Sub-Committees, its Cabinet and other meetings at which business of the Council is discussed.	
5.1.1.1.3		When acting as a representative of the Council.	
5.1.1.1.4		In taking any decision as a Cabinet member or as a Ward Councillor.	
5.1.1.1.5		In discharging your functions as a Ward Councillor.	
5.1.1.1.6		At briefing meetings with officers.	
5.1.1.1.7		At site visits or other visits to do with the business of the Council.	
5.1.1.1.8		When corresponding with the Council other than in a private capacity.	
5.1.1.2		GENERAL CONDUCT	
5.1.1.2.1		You must-	
5.1.1.2.2.1		Provide leadership to the Council and communities within its area, by personal example.	
5.1.1.2.1.2		Respect others and not bully or harass any person.	
5.1.1.2.1.3		Recognise that officers (other than political assistants) are employed by and serve the whole Council.	
5.1.1.2.1.4		Respect the confidentiality of information which you receive as a Councillor by-	
5.1.1.2.1.5	(i)	Not disclosing confidential information to third parties unless required by law and only then after receiving confirmation from the Monitoring Officer to do so; and	
	(ii)	Not obstructing third parties' legal rights of access to information.

5.1.1.2.1.7		Use your position as a Councillor in the public interest and not for personal advantage.	

- 5.1.1.2.1.8 Accord with the Council's reasonable rules on the use of public resources for private and political purposes.
- 5.1.1.2.1.9 Exercise your own independent judgement, taking decisions for good and substantial reasons by-
 - (i) Attaching appropriate weight to all relevant considerations including, where appropriate, public opinion and the views of political groups.
 - (ii) Paying due regard to the advice of officers, and in particular the advice of the statutory officers, that is the Head of Paid Service, the Chief Finance Officer and the Monitoring Officer.
 - (iii) Stating the reasons for your decisions where those reasons are not otherwise apparent.
- 5.1.1.2.1.10 Account for your actions, particularly by supporting the Council's scrutiny function.
- 5.1.1.2.1.11 In your decisions and actions apply the principles of selflessness, integrity, objectivity, accountability, openness, honesty and leadership and, as far as reasonably possible, assist the Council to act within the law.
- 5.1.1.2.1.12 Promote equalities and not discriminate unlawfully against any person.

5.1.1.3 <u>DISCLOSABLE PECUNIARY INTERESTS</u>

- 5.1.1.3.1 You must-
- 5.1.1.3.1.1 Comply with the statutory requirements to register, disclose and withdraw from participating in respect of any matters in which you have a disclosable pecuniary interest (see **Annex 1**), and specifically,
 - (i) Ensure that your entries in the register of interests are kept up to date and notify the Monitoring Officer in writing within 28 days of becoming aware of any change in respect of your disclosable pecuniary interests.
 - (ii) Make verbal declarations of the existence and nature of any disclosable pecuniary interest at any meeting at which you are present where an item of business affects or relates to the subject matter of that interest is under consideration, at or before the consideration of the item of business or as soon as that interest becomes apparent.
 - (iii) Withdraw from any meeting at which you have a disclosable pecuniary interest during the entire consideration of that item, unless a dispensation has been granted.

5.1.1.3.2 "Meeting" means any meeting organised by or on behalf of the Council and in particular in the circumstances as set out in paragraph 5.1.1.1 of this Code.

5.1.1.4 <u>OTHER INTERESTS</u>

- 5.1.1.4.1 In addition to Paragraph 5.1.1.3, if you attend a meeting and there is an item of business to be considered in which you are aware you have a non-disclosable pecuniary interest or non-pecuniary interest, you must make a verbal declaration of the existence and nature of that interest at or before the consideration of the item of business or as soon as that interest becomes apparent.
- 5.1.1.4.2 You have a non-disclosable pecuniary interest or non-pecuniary interest in an item of business of your Council where-
- 5.1.1.4.2.1 A decision in relation to that business might reasonably be regarded as affecting the well-being or financial standing of you or a member of your family or a person with whom you have a close association to a greater extent than it would affect the majority of the Council Tax payers, ratepayers or inhabitants of the ward or electoral area for which you have been elected or otherwise of the Council's administrative area;
- 5.1.1.4.2.2 It relates to an interest concerning either of the following-
 - (i) Any person or body who employs or has appointed you;
 - (ii) Any contract for goods, services or works made between Chelmsford City Council and you or a firm in which you are a partner, a company of which you are a remunerated director, or a person or body of the description that would create a disclosable pecuniary interest but only where it has been fully discharged within the last 12 months.

5.1.1.5 <u>REGISTRATION OF INTERESTS</u>

- 5.1.1.5.1 Where you are required to notify the Monitoring Officer as to any interest registerable under the Localism Act 2000 or this Code, you should do so using the City Council's agreed Notice of Registerable Interests form.
- 5.11.5.2 The Monitoring Officer has issued guidance in the form of a
 Constitution Practice Note to assist in your completion of the Notice,
 but it is your responsibility to ensure that the content of the Notice is
 accurate, complies with the legal requirements and that all registerable
 interests are notified to the Monitoring Officer within the appropriate
 timescales.

5.1.1.6 GIFTS AND HOSPITALITY

You must not accept gifts, benefits or hospitality, irrespective of estimated value, which could give rise to real or substantive personal or political gain or a reasonable suspicion of influence on the councillor's part to show favour from persons seeking to acquire, develop or do business with the local authority or from persons who may apply to the local authority for the grant of, or an objection to any permission, licence or other significant advantage.

- You must within 28 days of receipt notify the Monitoring Officer in writing of any gift, benefit or hospitality with a value in excess of £50, which you have accepted as a Councillor from any person or body other than the Council, including the name of the donor. The Monitoring Officer will place your notification on a public register of gifts and hospitality which is published on the Council's website.
- 5.1.1.6.3 The duty to notify the Monitoring Officer does not apply to a gift, benefit or hospitality that comes within any description approved by the Council for this purpose.

Annex

Definitions

The duties to register, disclose and not to participate in respect of any matter in which a member has a Disclosable Pecuniary Interest are set out in Chapter 7 of the Localism Act 2011.

Disclosable Pecuniary Interests are defined in the Relevant Authorities (Disclosable Pecuniary Interests) Regulations 2012 as follows-

Interest	Prescribed Description
Employment, office, trade, profession or vocation	Any Employment, office, trade, profession or vocation carried on for profit or gain.
Sponsorship	Any payment or provision of any other financial benefit (other than from the relevant authority) made or provided within the relevant period in respect of any expenses incurred by M in carrying out duties as a member, or towards the election expenses of M. This includes any payment or financial benefit from a trade union within the meaning of the Trade Union and Labour Relations (Consolidation) act 1992
Contracts	Any contract which is made between the relevant person (or a body in which the relevant person has a beneficial interest) and the relevant authority- (a) under which goods or services are to be provided or works are to be executed; and (b) which has not been fully discharged
Land	Any beneficial interest in land which is within the area of the relevant authority
Licences	Any licence (alone or jointly with others) to occupy land in the area of the relevant authority for a month or longer

Corporate tenancies	Any tenancy where (to M's knowledge) – (a) the landlord is the relevant authority; and (b) the tenant is a body in which the relevant person has a beneficial interest
Securities	Any beneficial interest in securities of a body where- (a) that body (to M's knowledge) has a place of business or land in the area of the relevant authority; and (b) either- (i) the total nominal value of the securities exceeds £25,000 or one hundredth of the total issue share capital of that body; or (ii) if the share capital of that body is of more than one class, the total nominal value of the shares of any one class in which the relevant person has a beneficial interest exceeds one hundredth of the total issued share capital of that class

For this purpose-

"the Act" means the Localism Act 2011;

"body in which the relevant person has a beneficial interest" means a firm in which the relevant person is a partner or a body corporate of which the relevant person is a director, or in the securities of which the relevant person has a beneficial interest;

"director" includes a member of the committee of management of an industrial provident society;

"land" excludes an easement, servitude, interest or right in or over land which does not carry with it a right for the relevant person (alone or jointly with another) to occupy the land or to receive an income;

"M" means a member of a relevant authority;

"member" includes a co-opted member;

"relevant authority" means the authority of which M is a member:

"relevant period" means the period of 12 months ending with the day on which M gives a notification for the purposes of section 30(1) or 31(7), as the case may be, of the Act;

"relevant person" means M or any other person referred to in section 30(3)(b) of the Act;

"securities" means shares, debentures, debenture stock, loan stock, bonds, units of a collective investment scheme within the meaning of the Financial Services and Markets Act 2000 and other securities of any description other than money deposited with a building society.

Further definitions in relation to the Code of Conduct to note:-

"Bullying" – The Advisory, Conciliation and Arbitration Service (ACAS) characterises bullying as offensive, intimidating, malicious or insulting behaviour, an abuse or misuse of power through means that undermine, humiliate, denigrate or injure the recipient. Bullying might be a regular pattern of behaviour or a one-off incident, happen face-to-face, on social media, in emails or phone calls, happen in the workplace or at work social events and may not always be obvious or noticed by others.

"Harassment" – The Protection from Harassment Act 1997 defines harassment as conduct that causes alarm or distress or puts people in fear of violence and must involve such conduct on at least two occasions. It can include repeated attempts to impose unwanted communications and contact upon a person in a manner that could be expected to cause distress or fear in any reasonable person.

"Unlawful discrimination and equality duties" – Unlawful discrimination is where someone is treated unfairly because of a protected characteristic. Protected characteristics are specific aspects of a person's identity defined by the Equality Act 2010. They are age, disability, gender reassignment, marriage and civil partnership, pregnancy and maternity, race, religion or belief, sex and sexual orientation.

Introduction

I am investigating your complaint regarding Wendy Daden which was made on 28 October 2021. I will be considering all of the relevant information and evidence in this matter and will produce an investigation report which will be sent to Lorraine Browne, Monitoring Officer for Chelmsford City Council.

I will be taking notes as we talk and will send a copy after the interview for you to consider. Those notes will then form part of my investigation report.

Questions

Do you reside within the ward of Broomfield and the Waltham's (parish of Broomfield/ are a constituent of Broomfield Parish Council?) i.e. is Cllr Daden your Parish/Ward Councillor as well as City Councillor?

Yes, she is the Parish Councillor and City Councillor. I have no personal grievance against Wendy Daden and I have found her newsletters very helpful in the past. After raising my concern she did hand deliver my Christmas Card and explained that whilst we may have a difference in views, she is still there to assist should I need her help.

I note in your complaint you refer to Wendy Daden regularly sending 'round-robin' email newsletters to constituents. How did you come to receive these? Did you sign up for these emails?

The newsletters are called Daden news and are received by email. I must have signed up/agreed to receive them though don't recall when. When Wendy Daden got in as an Independent it is likely that I would have agreed to receive these at this time.

Do you consider you signed up to receive information from Wendy Daden as a private citizen or as a Councillor?

Clearly in her capacity as a local councillor/ council representative, feeding back on council proceedings, local interest items and local issues.

How frequently do you receive these 'round-robin' emails?

Not sure how often these are received. Only took issue with the ones referred to in my complaint.

I have seen a copy of two documents, one titled Wendy Daden and the second, titled Daden News. Please could you confirm that both of these were received by email and when?

The first was 19 September 2021. I then emailed Wendy in response - these emails were supplied with my complaint. Second was received 25 October 2021.

How do the content of these emails/newsletters differed from other emails/newsletter you have received from Wendy Daden?

Struck me and and others that these were different.

also a dog walker, so regularly meet and talk with others in the community and heard from others that there was similar information on Facebook and other social media that I do not use, and I was aware that other people were concerned about it. I was also aware that she was circulating leaflets which suggested people should lobby their GP.

What triggered my concern was that the 19 September newsletter was normal business content until right at the end with an entry marked 'Groundbreaking'. I presumed that she may have been hacked as tacked on the end was a promotional message for Ivermectin, basically encouraging people to follow up on this – referred to Pro choice, which is understood to link to anti vaccination groups. This raised my concern and I was going to contact her and ask if she had been hacked as this looked odd on the bottom of the normal newsletter. I have done own research into Ivermectin and felt I was talking from a reasonably informed position. That was why I responded the way I did in my email. As can been seen I state that I appreciate her communications but felt this was sensationalist and inappropriate in her capacity as a councillor as she was effectively promoting an unproven and controversial treatment.

You state in your complaint that 'Ms.Daden has also publicly and passionately sought to persuade local residents to engage in a campaign to promote Ivermectin..... by putting up posters, following links to anti vaxxers'. Please explain where you have seen this being promoted by Wendy Daden?

I have heard three or four other Broomfield residents express conern at Ms. Daden's strong promotion of Ivermectin, which they had possibly seen on social media or the Daden News email. (I do not use social media) which they thought inappropriate in her role as a councillor. It was not what they expected from a councillor. When I looked at the code of conduct, the only breach I felt this fell into was disrepute, in that she appears to be lobbying for an unproven so-called cure/preventative which is linked to conspiracy theorists and the anti vaccination movement. The links on the newsletter take you to this and research which has not been peer reviewed and appears to come from a closed community regarding this drug.

My other worry was that this came at a time when the Government were trying to get people to get their second vaccination – pressure was on – seemed to me that she was suggesting that Ivermectin is an alternative to vaccine, with her information stating that you don't get sick. Whilst it is true that you won't get sick from Ivermectin which is an anti-viral drug, I was concerned that the phrasing was suggesting that would not get sick from Covid if you took it, which I felt was irresponsible.

Is there anything else you would like to add?

Don't think so. I am not trying to be vindictive in any way. She is very welcome to her own views on these things and if she wants to hold anti-vaccination views that is up to her. In her email to me she states that she had never been comfortable with politicians meddling in medicine but I felt the newsletters were over the top and promotional which was outside of her responsibilities as a Councillor. Have your own ideas, but don't share with your constituents. I think everything else is self-explanatory within the documentation submitted in my complaint.

community will recognise her name and that she is a local councillor, and is therefore trying to take advantage of this position of authority and trust to influence the thoughts and actions of others. To emphasise my point, if I (as someone not well known in my community) were to create a leaflet, I would not put my name in large, bold letters next to a logo at the top of the leaflet as this would serve absolutely no purpose. In addition, the leaflet also advises readers to visit Cllr Daden's personal website, within which it is repeatedly stated that she is a local councillor. With regard to specific breaches of the code of conduct: - 5.1.1.2.1.7 - for the reasons stated above, Cllr Daden is using her position as a councillor for personal advantage and certainly not in the public interest. The leaflet claims that vaccines offer "zero safety." It is a leaflet about Covid vaccinations and contains references to Thalidomide, asbestos and cigarettes under the title "do you trust their science?" This is obviously not in the public interest as it is an attempt to scare members of my community into dismissing the advice given by public health experts and doctors - 5.1.1.2.1.11 - in her decision and action to create this leaflet, the principle of objectivity has not been applied. Almost the entire leaflet is subjective and therefore dangerous as it is trying to influence the reader's decisions regarding their health. "The worst medical advice ever is to do nothing for 14 days". "If you take it (Ivermectin), you will not get sick". These are just two examples of factually incorrect statements which completely lack objectivity.

It is my understanding that you accept that you produced/distributed the leaflet which is subject to this complaint. Please confirm if this is incorrect?

- 1) Was this leaflet sent out in your capacity as Parish and/or City Councillor?
- 2) What do you say in response to the complainants view that having a logo and name on the top of the leaflet has been done in a style that people would associate to politics?

The Complainant goes on to raise concern that the leaflet provides a link for your website www.wendydaden.co.uk which states you are a local councillor. I have reviewed your website and note it does refer to you as a Parish and City Councillor and provides information under the profile tab headings 'My Politics' and 'My Chelmsford Council Campaign'.

- 3) Does this website, in part or in full, relate to your position as a Parish and City Councillor?
- 4) If no, do you have any other form of website that provides information about you in your capacity as Parish Councillor and/or City Councillor? If so, please provide details of the same.

The Complainant alleges the following breaches of the code of conduct:

- 5.1.1.2.1.7 Use your position as a Councillor in the public interest and not for personal advantage
- 5.1.1.2.1.11 In your decisions and actions apply the principles of selflessness, integrity, objectivity, accountability, openness, honesty and leadership and, as far as reasonably possible, assist the Council to act within the law.
- 5) What is your view in relation to these alleged breaches?

Complaint 27/21 - Round Robin Email

Extract from complaint 27/21:

'Ms. Daden, an Independent member of the Council regularly sends 'round-robin' email newsletter to constituents which helpfully informs us of council business, local community activities and suchlike.'

I have interviewed the complainant and as part of this interview asked the following question (including complainants response):

Do you consider you signed up to receive information from Wendy Daden as a private citizen or as a Councillor?

Clearly in her capacity as a local councillor/ council representative, feeding back on council proceedings, local interest items and local issues.

There are two leaflets/newsletters referred to in this complaint, being one headed 'Wendy Daden Apolicital campaigner for transparent governance' and one headed 'Daden News'.

- 1) Was the first newsletter delivered in your capacity of either City Councillor or Parish Councillor?
- 2) Was the second newsletter (Daden News) delivered in your capacity of either City Councillor or Parish Councillor?
- 3) If no to the above two questions, do you accept the Complainants position that he signed up to receive these newsletters due to your capacity as city or parish councillor?

The Complainant alleges the following breach of the Code of Conduct:

- 5.1.1.2.1.6 Not conduct yourself in a manner which is likely to bring the Council into disrepute
- 4) What is your view in relation to this alleged breach?

Please feel free to add anything further you wish to be considered as part of my investigation.
