


Latest Achievements:

Tindal Square

The following has been accomplished since the last update:

- Concrete has been laid within the site to allow the new paving to be progressed up to the surface drain south of Tindal Square.
- The surface drain to the south of Tindal Square has been installed in line with the new paving.
- The installation of the tree pits for all ten trees has been completed, signifying a key milestone in the project.
- The installation of electrical ducting and sleeves for the new lighting columns has progressed.
- BT Openreach have completed their works to reconstruct the new underground chamber outside the Shire Hall.

Next steps:

Tindal Square

The next stages in construction for the project are:

- Works will begin outside the Shire Hall to remove the current steps in order to prepare the area for the new access ramp and ambulant steps.
- The works to install the surface drain to the south of Tindal Square will continue
- Paving will continue to be completed between The Garrison and Shire Passage entrance.
- Continuing with the electrical ducting installation throughout the area.
- The new CCTV cabinet will be installed in Shire Passage and the rainwater downpipe from HSBC will be connected to drainage system.




