**GENERAL NOTICE OF REGISTRABLE INTERESTS**

a member of Highwood Parish Council (“the authority”), set out below under the appropriate headings my interests, which I am required to declare under the Localism Act 2011 and the Council’s Code of Conduct and I have put “none” where I have no such interests under any heading.

**Disclosable Pecuniary Interests**  
**(Legal duty to provide this under the Localism Act 2011)**

Land</p> <p><i>Please include a clear description (including the postal address) of any land or buildings in which you or your partner have a freehold or leasehold interest which gives a right to occupy or receive income. The name of any person or body in which you or a person referred to above has a beneficial interest in securities of that body where:</p> <p>(a) that body to your knowledge has a place of business or land in the area of your authority; and</p> <p>(b) either-</p> <p>(i) the total nominal value of the securities exceeds £25,000 or one hundredth of the total issue share capital of that body; or</p> <p>(ii) if the share capital of that body is of more than one class, the total nominal value of the shares of any one class in which you or a person referred to above has a beneficial interest exceeds one hundredth of the total issue share capital of that class</p>
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**Other Pecuniary Interests**  
**(Required under the Code of Conduct not by legislation)**

**Registrable Non-Pecuniary Interests**  
**(Required under the Code of Conduct, not by legislation)**

**Members are only obliged to register their own interests under this heading and do not need to include the interests of husbands/wives/civil partners or others**

*Give details of any body to which you have been appointed by the authority.*

*Give details of all charitable and public bodies, pressure groups, trade unions and political parties to which you belong or which you help to manage.*

Your membership of or the fact that you are in a position of general management and control of any body:-

- a. to which you have been appointed or nominated by the authority
- b. exercising functions of a public nature
- c. directed towards charitable purposes
- d. one of whose principal purposes includes the influence of public opinion or policy (including any political party or trade union)

1. Any gift, benefit or hospitality with a value of at least £50, which you have accepted as a Councillor from any person or body other than the Council, including the name of the donor.

NOTE: A notification is required within 28 days of the receipt of any such item, so this is an ongoing requirement.

I recognise that it may be an offence under the Localism Act 2011 to:-

- (1) omit information that ought to be given in this notice;
- (2) provide information that is materially false or misleading;
- (3) fail to give further notices in order to bring up to date information given in this notice after my re-election or reappointment or to fail to declare a disclosable pecuniary interest that I acquire after the date of this notice and have to declare under the provisions of s.31 (2) Localism Act 2011.

I also acknowledge that it may be a breach of the Code of Conduct to:-

- (1) omit information that ought to be given in this notice;
- (2) provide information that is materially false or misleading;
- (3) fail to provide written notification to the authority's monitoring officer of any change in my interests contained in this notice within 28 days of my becoming aware of such change of circumstances
