TOWN AND COUNTRY FLANNING GENERAL DEVELOPMENT ORDERS 1973 TO 1976

Direction restricting permitted development on land lying to the South of Hawkswood Road South Hanningfield in the County of Essex

WHEREAS:

- (1) The Chelmsford District Council (hereinafter called "the Council") is the local planning authority under the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 (as amended by the Local Government Act 1972) for the Administrative District of Chelmsford
- (2) Article 3 of the Town and Country Planning General
 Development Order 1973 as amended (hereinafter called
 "the Order") permits the carrying out of certain development (as specified in the First Schedule to the Order)
 upon land to which the Order applies without the permission
 of the Council or the Secretary of State for the
 Environment
- (5) The Council is satisfied that it is expedient in the interests of amenity and the proper planning of the area to which this direction relates that development of Classes II.1, IV.2, V, IX and XXII specified in the said First Schedule to the Order should not be carried out within the area of land described in the Schedule hereto unless permission therefor is granted on an application duly made in that behalf


NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Article 4 of the Order HEREBY DIRECT that the permission granted by Article 3 of the Order in respect of the aforesaid classes shall not apply to the
