

Council Tax charges for 2023-24

We give notice that we set the Council Tax amounts on 22 February 2023 for the financial year beginning on 1 April 2023. The amounts relate to each of the categories of dwellings shown. This is in accordance with Section 30 and Section 38(2) of the Local Government Finance Act 1992.

Following a community governance review 2 new parish tier councils have been established, Chelmer and Chelmsford Garden.

How much do you have to pay?

We work out how much Council Tax we must collect by adding together the money each of the four authorities shown in the table below needs, as well as the parish tier council.

This year, the total Council Tax we need to collect is £140,038,778 not including parish tier councils.

If, for example your home is in band D, the average Council Tax for this year will be £1,978.99 plus an amount you have to pay to your local parish tier council (this is shown on your Council Tax bill).
