Slips and trips	Children may be focused on using the iPad/tablet and slip or trip.	Children warned in safety briefing to take care when moving around the museum with iPads/tablets.  Teachers, TA and education team must always supervise the children to ensure this is controlled.	2	2	4	L	
Sharp objects	iPad broken or damaged e.g. Glass screen cracks.	The iPad minis and tables for Sparky Trail all have coloured shock proof cased with handles to minimise the chances of damage if they are knocked or dropped.  All equipment is visually checked before use to make sure there is no visible damage.  First aiders are identified on signage at the front desk.  A pattern of repeat accidents will create a review of the activity being carried out to prevent injury.	2	1	2	L	
Violence and Aggression – Child Protection	Chelmsford Museum is part of Chelmsford City Council and abides by the child protection guidelines and procedures.	Museum staff are regularly trained and updated on child protection procedures. They are safeguarding trained to a minimum of level 2 and management at level 3. Schools staff accompany all visits and pupils are always supervised during learning sessions.	3	1	3	L	
Violence and Aggression – Child Protection	Images of children posted to external sites such as Facebook, Twitter, Instagram or other social media.  Inappropriate access to media such as websites, books, films or images.	The tablets with the Sparky trail cannot be connected to the internet. iPads do not contain a SIM card so they can only be connected to the internet via Wi-Fi. Wi-Fi connection is 'disabled' on iPad when being used by pupils during a session.  Only permanent museums staff upload and share films with schools, through Chelmsford City Council SharePoint system. Films/photographs with images of people are deleted from the Council system after they have been shared with the group leader, unless parent/guardians have signed Chelmsford City Council photo permission forms.	3	1	3	L

When groups are using the iPads for our Film Makers session or project, the group are required to provide photo permission consent from parents/guardians. When films have been shared with the school all recordings/photographs of children are deleted from the iPads before they are used by any other group or individual.  Films/images are only kept by Chelmsford City Council, when parents/guardians have signed Chelmsford Council photo permission forms giving consent for their use of images by the council for marketing/website/.	2	1	2	L

When iPads are used by groups (unless for Film Makers session or project), children are asked to photograph only exhibits and not each other.
