Private hire plate exempt conditions

1. The notice of exemption and identifying licence plate must be carried in the vehicle at all times and must be produced on the request of an Authorised Officer.
2. In the event of the loss or damage to either the licence plate or notification, the proprietor will seek a replacement immediately.
3. When operating under the exemption notice, the windscreen badge issued in respect of the vehicle will be displayed in the nearside front windscreen of the vehicle at all times.
4. The vehicle will not display any advertising, including company telephone numbers or logos.
5. The driver of a plate exempted vehicle will be smartly dressed at all times the vehicle is engaged on private hire work.
6. If there is any change of use of the vehicle, the proprietor will inform Chelmsford City Council in writing within 7 days.
7. The vehicle will not be used for normal private hire work.
8. A taximeter will not be installed in the vehicle.
