### COMPENSATION

Within 13 weeks after the loss or expense was incurred or (as the case may be) finished being incurred

No time limit (as soon as practicable)

Within 8 weeks from the date of the Council's decision not to pay compensation

Within 8 weeks from the date the Council receives the request for an internal review

Within 28 days of Internal Review Decision

# **Compensation Claims**

#### The owner or former owner:

- may bring a claim for compensation, in writing, for loss and expense incurred at the time of the asset being listed which would likely not have been incurred if the land had not been listed
  - must supply supporting evidence to the Council for each part of their claim

### Decision

Compensation claim Successful
Council agree compensation claim
Owner or former owner is paid compensation

Compensation claim Unsuccessful Council reject compensation claim and give reasons for the decision in writing

## Internal Review Request

Request for an internal review must be made in writing within 8 weeks from the date of the Council's decision not to pay compensation or against the amount of compensation

### Internal Review and Decision

The review will be carried out by a senior Council officer who was not involved in the original compensation decision

Compensation claim Successful Council agree compensation claim Owner is paid compensation Compensation claim Unsuccessful Council reject compensation claim and give reasons for the decision in writing

### Appeal to First-Tier Tribunal (General Regulatory Chamber)

Owner or former owner can appeal in writing to the General Regulatory Chamber of the First-Tier Tribunal
