
Brownies Local Knowledge Activity Badge at Chelmsford

Before you visit the museum:



Carnival Party Challenge


Your challenge is to plan a special 'Carnival Party' to celebrate Chelmsford's amazing history – people, places and events.

From Stone Age times right up to today, as different people have come to live in Chelmsford they have bought new recipes, stories and inventions.


Party treasure challenge
