

Boreham Neighbourhood Plan



Adoption Statement

Chelmsford City Council made the Boreham Neighbourhood Plan on 3 August 2026. This means that it is adopted as part of the statutory Development Plan for Chelmsford. This is in accordance with Regulations 19 and 20 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 (as amended).

Reason for the decision

The Boreham Neighbourhood Plan has been developed by the Parish Council through ongoing and extensive consultation within the parish. The majority of those who voted at a referendum on 30 July 2026 voted in favour of the Neighbourhood Plan. The City Council is required to 'make' a Neighbourhood Plan if more than half of those voting have voted in favour of the Plan. This is in accordance with Section 38(A)(4) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004.
